The ACERC functions as a coordinating and decision-making body responsible to the chancellor, and is charged to:

Audit and Management Advisory Services:

 Assist in ensuring Audit and Management Advisory Services is carrying out its mission and maintaining its objectivity and independence;

- Review audit results (external and internal), activity reports, status of corrective actions, and areas of concern;
- Approve changes to the annual audit plan;
- Make recommendations to the chancellor and provost to strengthen internal control systems on campus and at UC Davis Health;
- Evaluate the adequacy of resources of the Audit and Management Advisory Services department; and
- Review and approve the annual audit plan prior to submission to the UC Regents for approval.

Ethics, Compliance and Risk:

- Promote a culture that encourages all employees to conduct university business ethically and with a commitment to legal compliance;
- Provide executive-level oversight of university programs to ensure that they
 comprehensively address high priority risks as identified by the Compliance and Risk
 Council and the ACERC;
- Review and approve the annual compliance plan;
- Bring forward for discussion and coordination such high priority compliance and risk issues as may have university-wide implications or may require collaboration among several vice chancellor or vice provost units to resolve; and
- Make recommendations to the chancellor and provost to strengthen the compliance and risk programs on the Davis campus and at UC Davis Health.
